Flourish Textile Art Hub Membership - September

What you need to follow my tutorial - Please substitute if needed

- Photographs from summer inspiration, composition boxes (this will be included in the project, and drawing pen.
- 260gms / 9oz white cotton canvas - draw on 8 or 9 x 8cm square boxes in pencil. have a gap between each one (about 1cm) do not cut up, keep on one piece of canvas. plus a piece for colour mixing
- 1cm painting brush, Small bristle paint brush for monoprinting and mark-making, 1cm flat edge paint brush, small tip brush for touching up.
- Marking -making - cardboard, lego, bubble wrap or sequin strip, cones, feathers, whatever you can find
- Fabric paints for colour mixing, this will depend on your summer inspiration, pick a range of colours you think could work and go from there: I used white 10 Opaque, Turquoise 30 light fabrics, Moss green 28 Light fabrics, Grey 91 Opaque, Sky blue 86 Opaque, Turquoise 87 Opaque, Ultramarine 12 light fabrics, Buttercup 13 Opaque, Orange 12 Opaque, Black 19 Opaque,
- Other materials to play with, fabric for collage and oil pastels.
- Thread colours of your own choice depending on your artwork - I used polyester threads dark blue, teal and silver Gutermann col 9901
- Mounting artwork 300/ 320gms cotton rag paper - you can Khadi paper 30cm x 30cm or cut to your own size, I show you how I cut watercolour paper to a bespoke size, and Hi-tack all purpose glue
