## Flourish Textile Art Hub Membership - February

### What you need to follow my tutorial - Please substitute if needed

- 22cm x 22cm (9 inches x 9 inches) 260gms white cotton canvas / heavy iron-on interfacing
- 30cm x 30cm (12 inches x 12 inches) 320gms cotton rag paper - I used Khadi paper
- Marking-making - cardboard, lego, bubble wrap or sequin strip, cones, feathers - anything you can find!
- 3 jars / cups to hold different coloured paint / 3 different paint brushes
- Fabric paints: Choose your own colours: one light, one dark and 2 extra colours.  
my dark colour: Turquoise 30 Light fabrics, my contrasting light colour: I used portrait pink 90 Opaque,  
my 2 extra colours: I used Cinnamon 93 Opaque, Olive 83 Opaque
- Small bristle paint brush for monoprinting and glueing
- Botanical inspiration for embroidery I used an ivy branch. Only pick once ready to sketch.  
Sketchbook / paper and drawing pen 0.5 to sketch out embroidery
- Dark colour thread - I used a dark blue polyester.
- light weight / sheer fabric to add texture. Organza, voile, mess. I used scrim.(optional)
- hand embroidery thread - I used teal (optional)
- Hi-Tack craft glue for mounting - make sure its suitable for paper and fabric
