Flourish Textile Art Hub Membership - October

What you need to follow my tutorial - Please substitute if needed

- A selection of materials for collage - I used medium weight Lutradur, cotton rag paper 30cm x 30cm, Dobby Cotton (textured cotton, shirting weight), Mulberry lace paper
- Marking -making - cardboard, lego, bubble wrap or sequin strip, cones, feathers - anything you can find!
- Fabric paints: Choose own colours depending on inspiration. I used Raspberry 81 Opaque, Turquoise 87 Opaque, Ultramarine 12 Light fabrics and Sky blue 86 opaque, Grey 91 Opaque, I also used one spray paint in grey (I used textile paint but because I sprayed the paper you could use acrylic spray paint)
- Mediums for creating texture - Light Moulding Paste, or Setacolour Expandable paint or both!
- Wide flat brush for painting base colour, small bristle paint brush for mark-making
- 505 temporary adhesive
- Thread colours of your own choice depending on your artwork - I used dark teal and dark blue and silver metallic Hand Embroidery thread, teal and pink
- 30cm x 30cm (12 inches x 12 inches) 320gms cotton rag paper - I used Khadi paper for presentation
- Hi-Tack craft glue for mounting
